

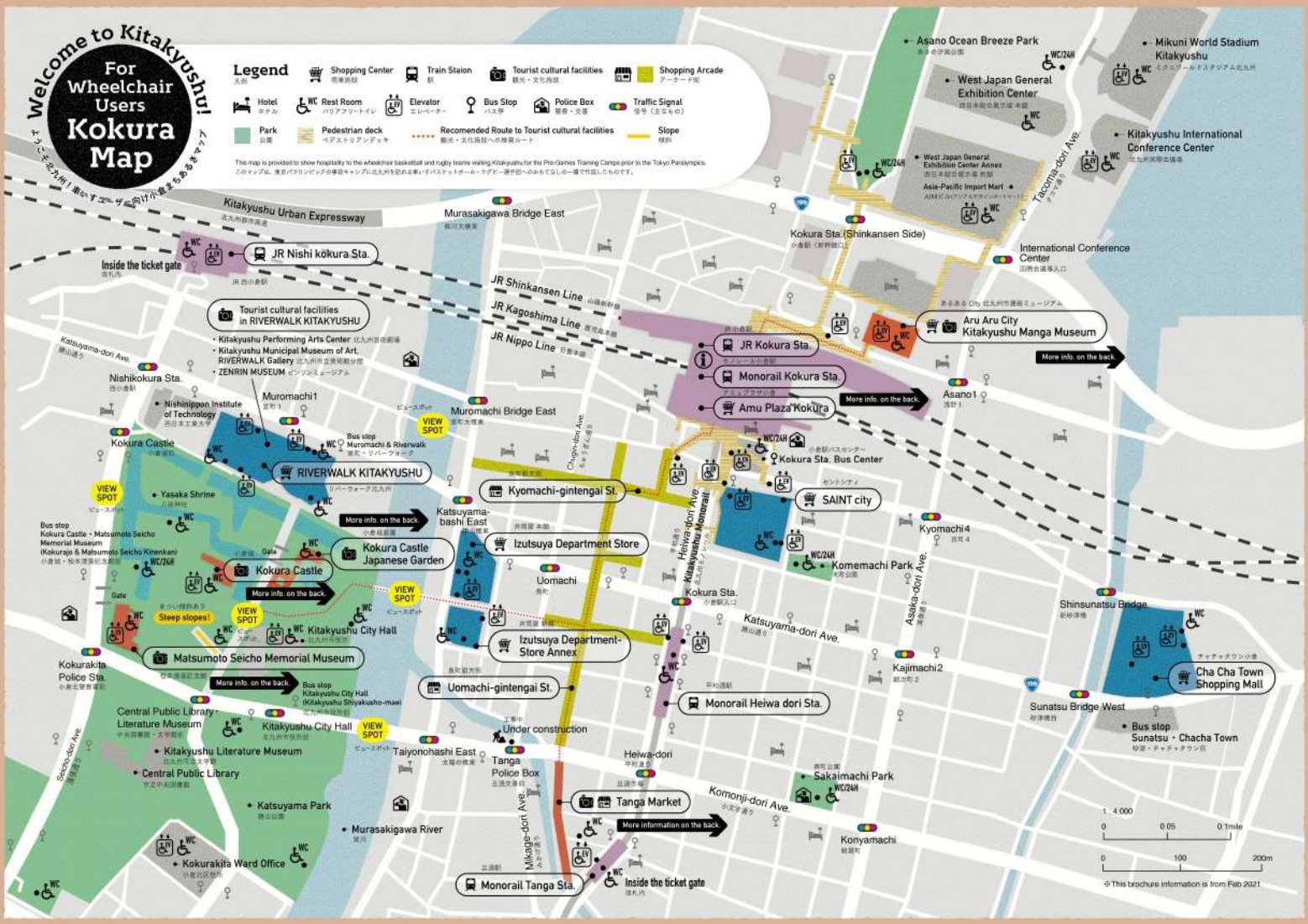

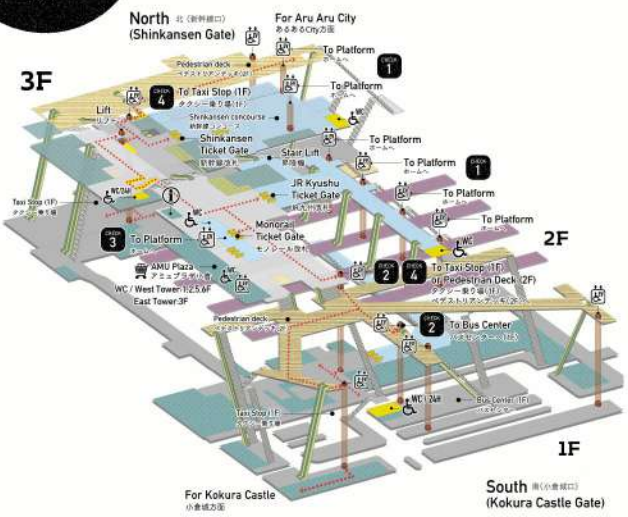

Check 1 Train information
JR Kyushu / JR West

Regular trains arrive via the JR Kyushu Line, Shinkansen (bullet train) arrives via JR West. (Ticket gates for both lines are on the 3rd floor.) Shinkansen ticket gates are lower level than Regular trains ticket gates. 定期券の改札、乗車券の改札は異なります。(いずれも別に改札、乗車券の改札は互換できません。)

Check 2 Nishitetsu Bus Information
Getting on and off Bus / Timetable search

To get to the Kokura Station Bus Center (on the 1st floor) from the 3rd floor, use an elevator to get to the pedestrian deck (on the 2nd floor), and then take an elevator from there to get to the 1st floor. 小倉駅バスセンター(1階)へは3階の改札でエスカレーターで降り、さらにエレベーターで降りてください。

Check 3 Monorail Information
Kokura Station

Regular trains arrive via the JR Kyushu Line, Shinkansen (bullet train) arrives via JR West. (Ticket gates for both lines are on the 3rd floor.) Shinkansen ticket gates are lower level than Regular trains ticket gates. 定期券の改札、乗車券の改札は異なります。(いずれも別に改札、乗車券の改札は互換できません。)

Check 4 Taxi Information

There are two taxi stands (on the 1st floor), with one located at the north exit and the other at the south exit of Kokura Station. They can be reached directly by elevator from the 3rd floor. 小倉駅タクシー乗り場(1階)は北出口と南出口の2か所があります。3階から直接エレベーターで降りることができます。

Kokura Castle / 小倉城
Constructed by Hosokawa Tadaoki in 1602. With the 5th floor larger than the 4th floor, the castle tower's "Nanankaku" style is unique.
Fee: 300yen(General), 200yen(Junior high school & high school students), 100yen(Elementary school students)
Hours: April-October 9:00-18:00, November-March 9:00-17:00
Admission is 30 minutes before business hours.
Access: This castle tower is located on a slight hilltop, and it may be difficult to access with a wheelchair. To access the castle tower from with a car or taxi, please call in advance (093-951-1210). Using the stair lift (twice) and the elevator, you can access the top floor.



Kokura Castle Japanese Garden / 小倉城庭園
A garden with a restored feudal lord's residence of the Edo Period. Enjoy the beautiful scenery of the four seasons. You can also try a Japanese traditional tea ceremony (10:00-14:00/800 yen).
Fee: 300yen(General), 200yen(Junior high school & high school students), 240yen(Elementary school students)
Hours: April-October 9:00-18:00, November-March 9:00-17:00
Admission is 30 minutes before business hours.
Access: Walk from JR Kokura Sta.(5min. on foot) / By Bus (Aurumachi & Fiveway)(Kokuryu City Hall Kitakyushu Shiyakusho-mae) bus stop.
Wheelchair users may need assistance to enter the residence as there are some steps.



Matsumoto Seicho Memorial Museum / 松本清張記念館
The prolific writer Matsumoto Seicho was born in Kitakyushu. His translated works are popular with many overseas fans.
Fee: 600yen(General), 360yen(Junior high school & high school students), 240yen(Elementary school students)
Hours: 9:30-18:00 Admission is 30 minutes before business hours.
Access: Walk from JR Kokura Sta.(19min. on foot) / By Bus (Kokura Castle-Matsumoto Seicho Memorial Museum)(Kokurajo & Matsumoto Seicho Kienkan) bus stop
Closing day: Year-end (December 29-December 31), 4th Monday of every month (the following day if Monday is a holiday)
* There is also a common ticket for 3 facilities with Kokura Castle and Kokura Castle Japanese Garden.



Kitakyushu Manga Museum / 北九州市漫画ミュージアム
A museum introducing a wide variety of manga culture. Many pop-culture stores are also in this building.
Fee: 400yen(General), 240yen(Junior high school & high school students), 100yen(Elementary school students)
Hours: 11:00-18:00 (Admission is 30 minutes before business hours)
Access: Connects directly by pedestrian deck from the 3rd floor of Kokura Station.(2min. on foot)
Closing day: Tuesdays (the following day if Tuesday is a holiday), year-end, New Year



Tanga Market / 旦過市場
With 100 years of history, "The Kitchen of Kitakyushu" features more than 100 shops.
Hours: 10:00-18:00(Each shop has its own hours)
Access: Walk from JR Kokura Sta.(5min. on foot) / The closest station is Monorail Tanga station.
Uramachi-gintengai St.: This was Japan's first shopping arcade street (with a roof).
Kiyemachi-gintengai St.: In the Edo Period (1603-1868), the highway from Kyushu to Edo (now Tokyo) stopped.
